Taos Mesa Brewing – Taos, N.M.

Kolsch (*Kölsch*) - 5.5% ABV 25 IBU

This light and crisp German style ale is made with European pilsner malt. Fermented with a traditional German Kolsch yeast hopped with German noble hops. A refreshing "light" beer.

Great Scot (*Scottish Ale*) - 7.5% ABV 15 IBU

Six different types of crystal malts are used in this strong scotch ale, creating a sweet and bold malt profile. The malt profile lends a beautiful dark red color. This is a bold yet smooth beer.

La Cumbre Brewing Co. – Albuquerque, N.M.

Elevated - I.P.A. -7.2% ABV 100 IBU

Did someone ask for hops? Tired of beers that promise a full lupulin experience, but never deliver more than richly malted bitterness? We've been brewing world class IPA's for years.

Marble Brewing Co. – Albuquerque, N.M.

Wildflower Wheat – 5.6% ABV 13 IBU

An unfiltered American Wheat Ale accented with New Mexico Wildflower Honey. Our "liquid sopapilla."

Santa Fe Brewing Co. – Santa Fe, N.M.

7 K - I.P.A. – 7.0% ABV 70 IBU

7K IPA is a dry, West Coast-ish style IPA with notes of grapefruit, citrus and tropical flavors. It's fruity and intense with a clean hop profile and leaner malt base than other IPAs.
